Thank you for joining us in **celebrating these "Saviours of the Environment"**.

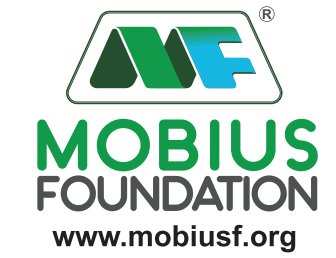
